Open Call for Faculty Position in Architecture and Design

The Architecture program at the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning at The Technion - Israel Institute of Technology invites applications for a tenured or tenure-track position in the field of Architecture, Design, Art and Cultural Production, that begins in the academic year of 2025-6. The position is open to junior as well as senior academics with a recognized record of teaching and research in the field of art and design. Salary and compensation will be comparable with Israeli university standards and include a generous start-up grant.

The Architecture program's primary mission is to harness architectural enterprise and research to perpetually challenge architectural and environmental thinking and advance new, experimental ideas that question the prevailing design conventions of the physical environment. The program is committed to developing new knowledge in the fields of architecture and the built environment through artistic and architectural design's vocabulary and traditions of workmanship alongside research methods and scientific investigation across diverse disciplines. From Yitzhak Danziger to Micha Ulman and Bilu Blich, the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning at the Technion has a long and rich legacy of promoting artistic production and exploring the interrelations between cultural and civic values through architecture, landscape architecture, plastic arts, as well as electronic and digital media.

Description of the field

Scholarship and practice in the field of architectural and environmental production, motivated by artistic and designerly theories and modes of action. Sensitivity to material culture(s), including the study of architectural experimentality, spatial activism, and conceptions of representation, reference, performance, communication, exhibition, and curation.

Qualifications

Successful candidates are expected to demonstrate an exemplary record of scholarship and teaching in their field compatible with their current rank, namely a capacity (1) to collaborate in multidisciplinary frameworks; (2) to develop a progressive vision of teaching pedagogies; (3) to develop a significant body of work in the art or design fields both in terms of his/her practice and research; (4) to bridge theory and practice, art and design through written scholarship; (5) to engage with academic leadership; (6) to develop public activities such as curatorial works that may reflect on his/her teaching and research agendas.

Preference will be given to applicants who hold at least one advanced degree in art and/or architectural design such as MFA and/or M.Arch. or a comparable graduate degree in a related field. Preference will be given to candidates holding a Ph.D. in Art, Architecture, Design, or related fields, and with a demonstrated record combining artistic and scholarly work.

Teaching may be conducted in English.

Academic rank will be determined in accordance with the candidate's record.

Key Responsibilities:

Conducting cutting-edge research in the field of Architecture, Art, Design, and Cultural Production.

Teaching undergraduate and graduate level courses and coordinating the undergraduate basic design curriculum.

Supervising graduate students.

Contributing to the academic and professional community through publications, conferences, and collaborative projects.

Engaging in service activities within the faculty.

Application Requirements:

Applicants should submit a teaching and research statement, a curriculum vitae, samples of design and artwork, two samples of written publications, sample of a course syllabus, and the names of three references.
